### Interview Questions

1. During the DPP ruling period, do you think Taiwan sets sustainable development as a national goal or is still focusing on a growth-oriented national development strategy which may assign less priority to environment protection in policy-making procedure?
2. What is the central government agency in charge of coordinating global warming policy? The EPA (a government organization) or NCSD (still Taskforce, there is a Climate Change and Kyoto Protocol Response Taskforce under the NCSD)? or other agency?
3. Whether the central coordinate agency is the EPA or NCSD (CCKPRT); can the EPA play the role of policy coordination being that the EPA is also the Secretariat of the NCSD and CCKPRT?
4. Do you think a single responsible agency is required to implement a global warming policy? The single responsible agency could be a new institution, such as the Ministry of Environment and Resources or the Council for Economic Planning and Development reorganized into the Council for Sustainable Development or another government agency.
5. Are there national guidelines which can help to coordinate different interests between economic growth and sustainable development (environmental protection) to address nationwide global warming issues?
6. In your opinion, do you think that national economic policies, such as “Big Investment, Big Warmth”, take global warming (GHG emission reduction) into consideration?
7. Do you think all regulations related to global warming issues have to be reviewed together to prevent discordance so as to efficiently implement the policies?
8. In your opinion, what is the main reason that Taiwan could not set GHG reduction targets and timetable during the two Energy Meetings, the National Meeting of Sustainable Development and the review of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act in the sixth Legislative Yuan?

9. In your opinion, do you agree with the setting up of GHG reduction targets and timetable?  
If yes, do you agree for it to be prescribed in law or a government agency authorized to make decision? Why?
  
10. In the post -Kyoto period, how should Taiwan face new upcoming reduction targets (such as planning a new response strategy)?
